## MEDICAL LICENSING SUPPORT AWARD

This scholarship was established to financially support first-generation medical students paying for their medical licensing exams. The winner will be presented with a Certificate of Achievement and have their work published on our website, along with a scholarship in the amount of **\$500** at the Fall House of Delegates Meeting or at the LMSA National Conference, which will take place from March 4th-6th, 2022 in Philadelphia.

### **Eligibility:**

Only first-generation medical students, who are active LMSA members currently enrolled in an accredited medical school, are eligible to apply. Applicants must also attend the LMSA-NE Regional Conference to receive the award. If you are unable to attend the conference, you must contact LMSA-NE Co-Director Elects at least one week before the conference with the name of the proxy representative from your affiliated chapter.

Applicants are required to submit a **250-word essay highlighting their commitment to underserved communities.**
