RESIDENCY APPLICATION AWARD

This scholarship was established to support 3rd and 4th year medical students paying for their residency applications. The winner will be presented with a Certificate of Achievement, along with a scholarship in the amount of **\$500** during the LMSA National Conference, which will take place from March 4th-6th, 2022 in Philadelphia.

Given the mission of providing mentorship and increasing the pipeline of diverse medical students, the idea behind LMSA+ we can offer a scholarship to cover costs for the application process

Eligibility:

Only active 3rd or 4th year LMSA members that are currently enrolled in an accredited medical school are eligible to apply. Applicants must attend the LMSA-NE Regional Conference to receive the award. If you are unable to attend the conference, you must contact LMSA-NE Co-Director Elects at least one week before the conference with the name of the proxy representative from your affiliated chapter. Previous winners are ineligible to apply.

Applicants are required to submit a **800-word personal statement**. Students are encouraged to submit their personal statement from their residency applications if completed.

All essays must be sent electronically to directorelect.northeast@lmsa.net by the end of the day of the specified deadline (refer to lmsane.org for all deadlines). Late entries will not be accepted.
