COMMUNITY IMPACT GRANT

This scholarship was established to encourage and support local LMSA chapters organizing and executing events in their communities. Preference will be given to future events that involve both one's medical school and local community. The winner will be presented with a grant amount of **\$500** at the Fall House of Delegates meeting.

Eligibility:

Only active LMSA members that are currently enrolled in an accredited medical school are eligible to apply. Applicants must also attend the Fall House of Delegates Meeting to receive their award. If you are unable to attend the conference, you must contact the Chief Financial Officer at least one week before the conference with the name of the proxy representative from your affiliated chapter.

Applicants are required to submit a **1-page proposal describing the event(s), how this initiative will benefit your community, and how the money would be allocated.**
