## WOMEN'S HEALTH ADVOCACY AWARD

In honor of Dr. Jack Ludmir's dedication to serve and advocate for the rights of women, this award is meant to recognize efforts aimed at improving women's healthcare. This includes, but is not limited to, advocacy, research, education, and community service. The scholarship will be awarded twice a year. The scholarship winner will be presented with a Certificate of Achievement along with a scholarship in the amount of up to **\$500** at the Fall House of Delegates Meeting or at the Annual LMSA-NE Regional Conference, hosted by the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai in NY, NY.

### **Eligibility**

Only active LMSA members that are currently enrolled in an accredited medical school are eligible to apply. Applicants must also attend the Spring or Fall House of Delegates Meeting to receive the award. If you are unable to attend the conference, you must contact us at least one week before the conference with the name of the proxy representative from your affiliated chapter.

Applicants are required to submit a one-page essay describing the activity/project, their involvement, and goals, as they relate to women's health.
